Vital Documents

Identification

☐ Social Security cards.
☐ Immigration or naturalization papers.
Property & Residence
☐ Home deed or lease agreement.
☐ Mortgage documents.
☐ Property tax records.
☐ Utility bills (for proof of address).
Financial & Legal
☐ Bank account and credit card info.
☐ Tax returns (last 2−3 years).
☐ Wills, powers of attorney.
Divorce, custody, or adoption papers.
☐ Titles for vehicles.
Medical
☐ Health insurance cards.
List of medications (names, dosages).
☐ Allergy and blood type information.
☐ Living will or medical directives.
☐ Copies of prescriptions.
☐ Emergency contact list (printed).
Medications & Health Supplies
☐ Prescriptions (in original containers).
Over-the-counter pain relievers, allergy meds.
☐ Glasses + backup pair / contacts & solution.
☐ Inhalers, insulin, EpiPens.
